COMPETITORS INFORMATION

Dear Competitors,

We thank you once again for your support in the past and hope this information will be of help to you again.

In order for us to guarantee a smooth course of the event, we appreciate if you could obey the following guidelines:

- **Entries**

Asia Max Challenge Round 3 will be held on 19/20 July as scheduled BUT THE VENUE HAS NOW BEEN CHANGED to SPEEDWAY PLUS ELITE circuit in **Subang Jaya, Selangor, Malaysia instead of Saraburi, Thailand. The cost of transporting karts to Thailand and also the requirement of a carnet made us decide to run the race in Malaysia.**

We are also running the RMC (Malaysian Series) Round 4 together with the AMC. Therefore the original scheduled date of June 28/29 is NOW NOT VALID. Instead it has been pushed back to 19/20 July. PLEASE TAKE NOTE.

Entries are open from now until 5 July, 2008. Entry forms and SR are available and are published in the KartingAsia web page, Kartmore Racing web page. Please arrange to have your entries submitted to the Race Secretariat now as it would save the organizer a lot of time in compiling the entries. If you send them late, your entry may not appear in the programme as well as having to pay double entry fees. You can submit your name and details by email and fax first.

Please ensure that you have a release letter from your ASN if you are a foreign competitor.

Fax or email your entry to the race secretariat first and bring the original to the signing in.

Make sure your license is in order for the class that you have entered.

Foreign competitors must have an International grade C license as a minimum.

- **Additional Information**

Subang Jaya is a municipality within the state of Selangor. It is a self contained city on its own. There are various areas to visit as well as many places to get different food. Shopping Malls are located in quite a number of areas.

Time difference: CET – 7 hours

Climate: 33°C - 37°C, high humidity, rain possible

Language: English widely spoken and understood

Electricity: 240V / 50 Hz, UK plugs

Currency: RM (Ringgit Malaysia) 1 USD = RM3.20
All major credit cards are widely accepted in Subang Jaya.

Competitors are advised to make your own hotel bookings directly with the hotels concerned.

Car Rental:

Widely available at the airport. Average size car would cost about RM120.00 per day. Vans would cost more in the region of RM200.00 upwards. Common car rental companies are Avis, Hertz, National, Orix and some local ones.

Food:

Subang Jaya is a shopping place and a wide range of food is available. There will be catering facilities at the track for everyone at moderate prices. There are several places further away from the track in USJ areas where many eating shops are located.

Beer and other liquor are widely available at coffee shops, Pubs and at the hotels.

The Kart Track

The track is about 20 km away from the Hotel Summit, USJ. It is located at Elite highway near the USJ Toll turnoff. Electricity is available in the pit area and as well as compressed air.

The track is 959 m long with 11 turns. Lap time of 43.7 - 44 sec clockwise direction. Sprocket used is 12-78 to 84. The track has undergone some renovation with new tyre walls done. Area of the road which has broken up has been repaired. There will be further improvements for this race.

There will be security at the track from Thursday until Sunday. However, we want to remind all competitors to be extra careful with their equipment. We will try our best to ensure security is available at all times. Wi-Fi is available at the track free of charge.

- **Tyres**

For the Formula Cadet class only DELI tyres will be allowed and for all the Rotax Max classes only MOJO tyres will be used. You can bring your own tyres for the race BUT you will be required to purchase ONE set from the Organisers during signing in and this set will be marked by the scrutineers to be used entirely for the race meeting. PLEASE NOTE THAT WE WILL BE USING MOJO **D2** TYRES FOR ALL ASIA MAX and RMC RACES. Only Mojo Wet tyres will be used for the race. You are allowed to bring your own rain tyres for the race but will have to be surrendered to the scrutineers during scrutineering.

- **Fuel and Lubricants**

Fuel is available at the nearby Caltex Service station not far from the track. We will designate that station to supply all the fuel for the competitors. FUEL TESTS WILL BE CONDUCTED. 2T will be available for sale at the track. They are Elf and MOTUL. If you have a preference for your own brand of 2T you will have to bring them yourself.

- **Drug Test**

We have been asked by our ASN to inform all competitors that drug taking during the course of a race is an offence. The Stewards may conduct random drug tests on competitors. BE WARNED.
